**1 in 7** People, including 1 in 5 children, struggles with hunger in Middle Tennessee

**397,150** Food-insecure individuals in our 46-county service area

**46** Counties in our service area covering 20,712 square miles in Middle and West Tennessee

**31,000,000** Pounds of food distributed

**26,000,000** Meals provided

**18,000,000** Meals provided through our network of 490 Partner Agencies, which include food pantries, soup kitchens, shelters, childcare facilities, senior centers, group homes and youth enrichment services

**9,000,000** Pounds of fresh produce distributed

**1,500,000** Pounds of fresh food sourced from farms within 800 miles of Nashville

**9,000,000** Pounds of food rescued, sorted, and distributed through our grocery rescue program, Middle Tennessee's Table

**89,177** Volunteer hours spent supporting our mission to feed hungry people and work to solve hunger issues in our community.

**2,000,000** Meals provided through our 16 Emergency Food Box locations

**110,535** Individuals who received assistance through our Emergency Food Box program

**151,211** Meals provided to families through 28 School Food Pantries

**152,657** Meals and snacks provided through our Kids Cafe, At-Risk Afterschool, and Backpack programs to low-income children

**5,251** Hungry children who received a bag of easy-to-prepare food through our Backpack Program to take home each weekend and during holidays

**4,400,000** Meals provided through 268 large-scale, one-day Mobile Pantry food distributions hosted by churches and Partner Agencies in primarily rural communities

**202,361** Individuals in needy families who were served at our Mobile Pantries

**4** Meals Second Harvest can provide for our hungry neighbors with each \$1 donated (96¢ of each \$1 goes directly to our feeding programs)
